

Short-term Rental Fire Safety Checklist



- Working smoke alarms are on every level of the home and outside of all sleeping areas
- Test your smoke alarms before every new guest
- An approved evacuation plan identifying rooms and emergency exits is visible and located at every entrance/exit
- Milton Fire & Emergency Services 911 emergency or non-emergency (905) 878-9251 numbers and the name/phone number of the emergency contact for the property are posted with the evacuation plan
- Working carbon monoxide alarms need to be located outside sleeping areas if you have any fuel burning appliances or an attached garage
- All windows and doors operate and are able to be opened
- The interior and exterior of all exits are free of obstructions
- Established rules for having small contained fires outside if the property has a burn permit
- Established rules for smokers including requesting that smoking be done outside and sturdy ashtrays should be used/emptied into a metal container
- Short term rental inspections are to be done on an annual basis
